Transition Employment Project

The Transition Employment Program is a one-week comprehensive pre-employment transition service held on the campus of the Arkansas School for Mathematics, Sciences, and the Arts (ASMSA). TEP was developed by the Arkansas Transition Project and the Arkansas Career Development Center. It was designed to assist high school students with disabilities that have completed the 11<sup>th</sup> grade in discovering their skills, abilities, interests, strengths, and career goals.



## Special Features of TEP

TEP provides career guidance and opportunities for participants to gain employability skills.

### Special Features of TEP Include:

- **Assessments:** Interest/Need Inventory
- **Work-based Learning:** Eligible to receive up to 100 hours of paid work experience
- **OSHA:** Occupational Safety & Health Administration general certification training provided by the Arkansas Career Development Center
- **Opportunity to Pursue Additional Career Certifications:** e.g., CPR
- **Job Exploration Counseling & Self-Advocacy**
- **Work-Place Readiness Training**
- **Post-Secondary Education Counseling**
